DISTRIBUTION WOOTTON COOLONGOLOOK BUNGWAHL BUNYAH BULAHDELAH

TAWNY FROGMOUTH (Podargus strigoides) at Patrick's. The bird that looks like a dead branch! Tawny Frogmouths mate for life and can live up to 14 years in the wild. They are nocturnal and carnivorous but are not owls. Unlike owls they have small feet without curved talons. This makes them walk as if they have gout, so they were given the genus name "Podargus" from the Greek words for gout, and species name "strigoides" meaning owl-like. They build nests from sticks and breed from August to December. At night the breeding pair take turns incubating the eggs, but the father normally takes the day shift. www.bushheritage.org.au/species/tawny-frogmouth
