

Veiny Wilkea Wilkiea huegeliana

A small tree up to 8m high and 10cm diameter, often with a crooked trunk. Leaves are stiff and toothed with prominent veins underneath. Male & female flowers are on separate trees. The fruit is a drupe, egg shaped, black & shining when ripe. Ripens between May & September. The protruding petiole allows for an extra exchange of oxygen. It is very common in practically every rainforest in NSW. This photo was taken recently in June at Keith Grahame's property at Wootton.

TREE I.D DAY

The tree identification day held at the Wootton Hall on the 20th June by Landcare and facilitated by Chris Scott, proved to be very popular with locals and those from surrounding areas. 32 people learnt how to identify plants using a keyed method which iden-



tifies leaf shape, structure, bark, location etc. The day rounded up with a visit to Keith Grahame's property where Chris walked us through the physical characteristics of a variety of trees. Chris was a wealth of knowledge who answered every question asked and helped us to gain a better understanding of this special environment we live in. Another I.D. day for those who missed out, will be held at a future date to be announced.

The **Coombell Farm Forestry Course** held over two days the following week was also very well attended and very useful for those interested in sustainable management of private native forests. We visited Eric Wilkes' mill who explained how he sources timber and what markets he supplies. We also learnt what the economic value of a saw log is. We then visited Keith's property for a practical session on sustainable timber management. Changing legislation was also discussed.
