

Stick insects are also commonly known as Walking Sticks. These insects are large to very large. They tend to resemble sticks, twigs or leaves. Usually they are green or brown in colour. They spend much of their time hanging motionless in plants, shrubs or trees. Even if they move, they sway slightly, as if caught by the movement of the wind. They are not easily seen because of their camouflage. Stick insects have powerful mandibles. They are herbivorous, eating plant leaves only, usually broad-leaved plants. In general, females are much larger

than males. The male can fly, but the female can only glide. Stick insects prefer a humid environment. The stick insect egg or ova has a very characteristic form. It has a very hard and tough shell. There is a cap at one end, called a capitulum, which the baby insect pushes off when it comes out of the egg case. In general, most stick insect eggs look like seeds. Some ants will even pick them up and keep them as if they are real seeds. Most stick insects just drop their eggs onto the ground. Often seen in Wootton so be aware when collecting your kindling.


