White Headed Pigeon Columba leucomela The White-headed Pigeon is endemic to rainforests in eastern Australia. It is a close relative of the domesticated pigeon and is of similar size and shape. In forests this pigeon is difficult to observe. By contrast, round towns and farms it may form large flocks to feed, especially on fallen fruits of the exotic Camphor Laurel. When nesting, it is detected most readily by its loud booming calls. Seen in our area now. They are extremely timid, so approach carefully.



Total Fire Ban Rules: During a Total Fire Ban no fire may be lit in the open. Fire permits are suspended during a Total Fire Ban. This includes incinerators and barbecues which burn solid fuel, eg: wood or charcoal. You may use a gas or electric barbecue but only if:

- It is on a residential property within 20m of the house or dwelling
- If it is a picnic area and the appliance is approved by Council, National Park or State Forest.
- It is under the direct control of an adult
- The ground within 2m of the barbecue is cleared of all materials which could burn
- You have an immediate and continuous supply of water available Please contact Robyn Smith on 49977209 or Mike Badcock on 49977337 for permits in the Wootton area.

How will you know if a Total Fire Ban is declared? Check the RFS website Current Fire Danger Map or call NSW RFS (1800 679 737). Total Fire Ban Recorded Information 9898 1356. Announcements are also made in newspapers, radio and TV.

Boiled Fruit Cake

125g butter or substitute 1 cup brown sugar

375g mixed fruit

1 teaspoon mixed spice

1/2 teaspoon nutmeg

1/2 tablespoon carb soda

1 cup water

Put everything, except eggs and flour, in a saucepan and bring to the boil. Simmer gently for 3 minutes.

2 eggs, slightly beaten

1 cup self raising flour

1 cup plain flour

Take off the heat and cool.

Heat oven to 180 degrees.

Line a round 20cm cake tin with baking paper.

When butter/sugar mixture is cool add the 2 eggs and then the sifted flour.

Pour mixture into prepared cake tin.

Cook in a moderate oven (Gas 180 degrees) for 1 1/2 hours.

This cake can be iced and should be eaten straight away but will keep about a week. From Mum's recipe book. This is a light fruit cake and tastes delicious. Happy Christmas eating. Pat Tate
