LAND MULLET (Bellatorias major) Australia's largest skinks can grow up to 60 cm and live up to 23 years. Their black-brown scales assist with rapid body warming in the restricted sunlight of the rainforest where they live. They shelter in hollows and burrows around fallen trees and are normally very shy, but some have started scavenging close to humans for scraps at picnic and camping sites. Land mullets do not hatch their young from eggs, instead they bear live young with 4 to 9 independent offspring per litter. Largely solitary, they eat woody fungi, mushrooms, berries, seeds, insects such as beetles and grasshoppers as well as decaying fruit material.


