DISTRIBUTION 400 WOOTTON COOLONGOLOOK BUNGWAHL BUNYAH BULAHDELAH

Long Leaved Mock Olive Notelaea longifolia

A bushy shrub or small tree growing in or on the fringes of all types of rainforest, particularly the drier scrubs and also Eucalypt forest. The plant is characterised by

their long leathery leaves. The yellow racemes flower from May to September followed by the purplish/black oval drupe shaped fruit ripening November to February. The fruit is a major source of food for the native doves and pigeons which are often seen feasting on the tree. The creamy coloured bark is covered with conspicuous white lenticels (raised dots).
