Red Necked Pademelon Thylogale thetis

The common Red-Necked Pademelon is a creature of the forest edge. They inhabit the dense rainforests and Eucalypt forests of Eastern Australia. They graze on short green grasses and shrubs until shortly before dawn. A very timid animal and rarely moves more than 100m from the forest edge to a clearing. Their body length i between 290 and 620mm and are distinguished by their reddish neck and shoulders. Their tail is held rod-like when hopping. Many have been sighted recently.
